That's when ACLI Association guessed that **work represents** the milestone to start over.

Training **takes** place wherever it is possible: in clubhouses, churches and abandoned buildings, but soon the need for a more structured training arises.

Therefore, in 1947, the Central Office for Vocational Training is created in Rome and, in 1951, it becomes EnAIP, Ente nazionale ACLI Istruzione Professionale. The first training courses are offered to youngsters and adults, men and women as an opportunity for social rewards.

Times change and EnAIP grows bigger.

It acts as a spokesperson for social and labour changes anticipating trends and taking part in the political process that leads to significant national reforms, thus becoming the first institution to develop a new and unique training proposal.

Today EnAIP is the largest vocational training provider in Piedmont, where everyday trainers, trainees, territories, companies, projects, failures, revivals, exchange of ideas blend.

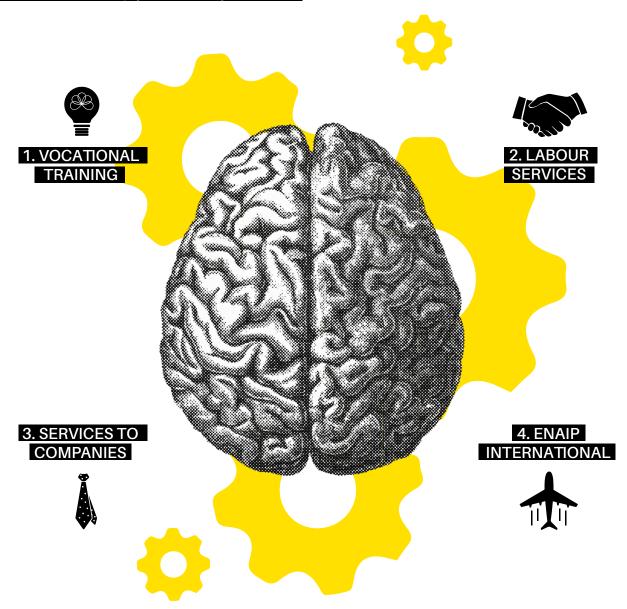

>> Learning by doing

Youngsters are our future, and this is why we devote to them most of our time. How? Through educational paths, that can enhance their talents, alongside with professional programmes aimed at making them enter the labour market or create their own business

We offer three-year free courses for youngsters who

have completed compulsory schooling, or until the age of 24, funded by the Piedmont Region and by the ESF. At the end, students achieve a

Professional Qualification.

These courses offer an internship during the third year either in Italy or, in some cases, also abroad. In the dual system courses, half of the path is carried out in a company.

Thanks to the Frasmus Plus



Programme, learners can also decide to carry out a short-term internship in an EU country. After the qualification, you can enrol for the fourth year and achieve a

Professional Diploma.

We use innovative didactic methodologies based on **cooperative learning** and learning by doing, **to enhance inclusion, active**

participation and competence, in order to reduce the number of dropouts. Even after a school failure, you can reach unexpected goals.

The reference sectors are hairdressing, industrial automation, electricity, beauty and wellness, multimedia graphics, industrial and car mechanics, catering, heating and plumbing, tourism and sales.

>> Another chance

We have always believed that work has an economic purpose, but most of all, it is related to individuals and their identity. In our centres, individuals who are looking for a job can find information, training and opportunities offered by the labour market.

These are places where everyday people live rebirth stories, because, for adults,



sitting behind a school desk again means believing themselves again, creating or recreating their life project.

Every year, we design and deliver a wide range of **free courses**, funded by the Piedmont Region and by the ESF, which provide a

Qualification or **Specialisation certificate** and, thanks to an

internship, enable individuals to quickly enter the labour market.

This represents an opportunity also for those who have lost their job and need to re-enter the labour market. Advanced age and the lack of new competences can often make the individual less attractive, causing financial troubles and self-esteem issues.

>> ITS & IFTS: another way

In the field of training we provide excellence nobody knows about: we play an active role in the regional- and national recognised Foundations and we provide ITS and IFTS courses, Further Training courses carried out in co-operation with higher technical schools, universities and large enterprises.

ITS paths are two-year free

courses, funded by the Piedmont Region and the ESF. They are addressed to recent high-school or university graduates and have 82% employment rate among learners finishing the course.

Their success is related to three factors. First of all, courses are carried outin **co-operation** with companies and they reach to the real labour market

needs. Secondly, 70% of trainers come from the labour market. Lastly, 42% of the path is spent in internships, which are designed to complete the theoretical training and the workshop activities.

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IFTS paths are one-year free courses, that last 800 hours in two semesters; 30% of the total hours must be spent in companies, in Italy or abroad.

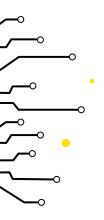

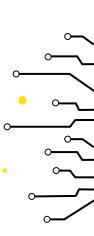

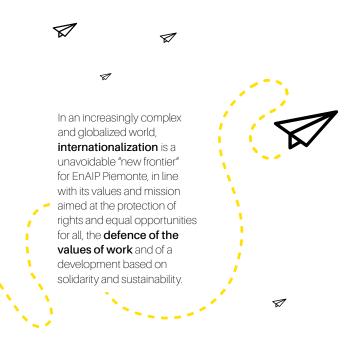
